

IRS form 4506-C Processing Update

In 2021 the IRS sent notification of their plan to transition the IVES program to an automated process starting in October 2021, that process update deadline has been extended a number of times and today we are notifying clients that **the deadline for**compliance has been moved from March 1, 2022 to October 1, 2022.

This system enhancement will have many benefits for obtaining transcripts, specifically much faster turn times. However, this will impact our clients, as some adjustments will need to be made to the way the 4506-C is filled out by the lender <u>prior to obtaining borrower signature</u>. We would like to provide an overview of this change and the necessary adjustments your processing teams will need to implement.

An Optical Character Recognition software will be used to read the 4506-C form, so for orders to be processed correctly the following will be required:

- The 4506-C must be clear of any editing marks.
- Only identify the transcripts, tax years and/or taxpayers that need to be processed.
- Every line must be filled out clearly, accurately, and completely.

Effective October 1st Advanced Data will no longer be able to process a 4506-C order, if the information listed on line 5a is incorrect, the IRS will reject any form that has inaccurate vendor information or appears to have been altered in anyway.

The information below needs to be listed on line 5a in its entirety:

Please note, ALL transcripts checked, and years listed on the 4506-C will be returned by the IRS, incurring an IRS Report Fee for each returned transcript. Please ensure that ONLY the <u>required borrowers</u>, <u>transcripts & years</u> are selected on the 4506-C, <u>before</u> it is signed by the borrower.
